Brief Bio

Ed Martini is Professor of History at Western Michigan University, where he currently serves as Associate Provost of Extended University Programs.

Martini's teaching and research interests focus on the intersections of political, cultural, environmental, and diplomatic history, with an emphasis on the history and legacies of American warfare. He is the author and editor of several books, including *Invisible Enemies: The American War on Vietnam, 1975-2000* (2007), *Agent Orange: History, Science, and the Politics of Uncertainty* (2012), and *At War: The Military and American Culture in the Twentieth Century and Beyond* (2018).

Martini is currently working on a global history of napalm and serves as co-editor of the University of Massachusetts Press book series, "Culture and Politics in the Cold War and Beyond."
